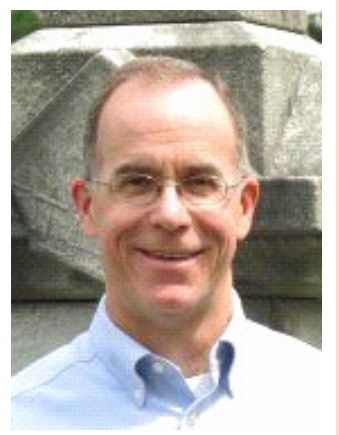
Should You Add DNA Testing To Your Genealogy Toolbox?
